Iprobenphos : < 0.01 mg/kg [ppm]

Triazophos

 $: < 0.01 \, \text{mg/kg [ppm]}$

Profenofos

< 0.05 mg/kg [ppm]

All the export consignments of Chilli & Chilli products as well as Cumin & Cumin products meant for Japan should be subjected to Mandatory sampling and Certification by the Spices Board for pesticide residues of Ethion, Iprobenphos, Triazophos and Profenofos.
