Sub: Mandatory Sampling & Testing of export consignments of Spices & Spice products under the Quality Evaluation System of Spices Board-reg

Ref: Circular No. MKT-MISC/0054/2013 dated 21.03.2014

It has been brought to the notice of the Board by the exporters of cumin seed (whole) that up to a quantity of 29.5 MT can be loaded to trucks/containers for export through road/sea. Accordingly, the Board has received a number of requests from the stakeholders to consider the lot size of cumin seed (whole) for export from the existing lot size of 27 tons to 29.5 tons so to reduce the cost of testing of the consignment for export.

In view of the above and to facilitate the Cumin export from the country, the Board has considered the request of the industry and decided to increase the lot size of Cumin seed(whole) from the existing lot size of 27 tons to 29.5 tons, irrespective of the export destination.

This circular, issued under the provisions of the Spices Board Act 1986 & Spices Board (Registration of Exporters) Regulations 1989, will take effect from 07/07/2022 and shall remain in force until further guidelines / instructions are prescribed by Spices Board, in this regard.
