

QUOTATION NOTICE

The Spices Board invites quotations for making and fixing tin sheets on already erected hoardings in different locations in Idukki district, Kumarakom in Kottayam district, SL Puram in Alleppey district and at Lower Camp, cumbum and Bodinayakanur in Tamil Nadu.

The particulars are:

1. Size of hoarding - 30' X 20'
2. Locations - Lower Camp, cumbum and Bodinayakanur in Tamil Nadu, Kumarakom in Kottayam district, SL Puram in Alleppey district, Valanjanganam, Chakklupallam, Chottupara, Thondimalai, Poopara, Myladumpara [two hoardings], Irumpu palam [Near Adimaly], Pallivasal, Santhanpara.

In Santhanpara, the work involves erecting the hoardings [now dismantled]

3. The hoardings are to be fitted with quality thin sheets. Many of the hoardings are erected in windy locations and hence will have to be provided with wind holes to withstand pressure of winds
4. The sheets are to be applied with primer over which painting using quality paint to be done as per the design provided by the Board. The materials involved are to be provided by the contractor.

5. The design will involve multicolour with graphics and drawing of figures. Letters will be in English, Hindi, tamil and Malayalam. Work will be allotted on condition that the contractor assures execution of the work artistically and completion of the work with perfection.

You are requested to submit your competitive rates as per the following format.

1. Rates for fixing the sheets in all the locations, give location wise rates.
2. Rates for painting and finishing the work as per the design, locationwise.

The design will be provided by the Board.

3. The rate for re-erecting the hoarding [the entire structure is currently dismantled and kept at Santhampara] as mentioned above may also be indicated separately.
