CIRCULAR

Sub: Health Certificate for the importation of dried curry leaves into the European Union from India.

Ref: 1.This office circular No.MKT-QUC/0001/2013 dated 15.01.2013 2.This Office circular No.MKT/EU/Gen/0001/2016-Marketing dated 27.1.2016 & 16.02.2016

The Board had introduced mandatory testing on pesticide residue for three parameters ie. profenofos, Triazophos and Endosulfan in dried curry leaves for export to EU with effect from 18th January 2013. The Board has received Notifications from the European Union on Rapid Alert System for Food & Feed(RASFF) due to the absence of Health Certificate for curry leaves. As per the EU Regulation 885/2014, the Commission imposes special conditions governing import of curry leaves from India due to contamination risk by pesticide residues and also accompanied by a Health Certificate in accordance with model certificate as set out in Annexure II of the regulation.(Copy attached).

It is informed that export of dried curry leaves to EU shall be accompanied with the analytical report issued by the Board and health certificate issued by EIC / EIA on the strength of Board's analytical report with immediate effect.
