

Sir,

In continuation of this Department's letter of even number dated 20th December, 2017 on the subject cited above it is informed that the competent authority in DAC&FW has decided to extend the implementation of the SOP for export of dried chili till June, 2018. This decision may be circulated to all the concerned stakeholders immediately and also inform that w.e.f. 1st July, 2018, Chili export to any country will be allowed only from the warehouses which are registered with the Plant Quarantine Stations.
