








## How to access Multiple Projects



#### Important Details about the Multiple Project Feature

- Users can add multiple projects in a single NSWS account and apply for a different set of approvals under each project
- On log-in, users will land on the default project (last created)
- Project-specific approvals can be added from the 'All Approvals' page or KYA (Central and State) or from an existing project
- Messaging window will be project specific to respond to the clarification raised by any ministry/department
- Approval specific payments will be managed under respective projects
- Documents uploaded during application submission will be common / global for all projects registered under one account and would be available to access across all projects created

Application Status	Description
Initiated	If an applicant has already submitted the filled application from NSWS portal and due to some temporary/ technical glitch the application does not integrate with the Ministry system, the status will temporarily reflect as Initiated.
Query Raised	If the processing authority has asked for further inputs from you, it will change your application status to "query raised".
Rejected	If an application is rejected, that will be shown in the Application Status. The applicant can make a fresh application again.
Approved	Once approved, the application status will reflect that, and the applicant can download a copy of the approval from the document repository.
Re-Initiated Self	Ministry specific status (For CDSCO under Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, if the user is uploading additional documents post submission (apart from prerequisite documents required for specified approval); status will change to reinitiated self)









## What are the technical Requirements for NSWS

#### System Requirements for National Single Window Portal

- Windows OS (XP or higher)
- MAC OS (X 10.9 or higher with latest updates)
- View/ Download Pdf: Download the pdf reader to view and download the pdf files from the link: https://get.adobe.com/reader/)
- Platform requires a minimum screen size of 976px wide, but using 1024px or higher is recommended
- Digital Signature Certificate (DSC): Latest version of emBridge software need to be installed in the system which acts a connecting link/driver between the NSWS and DSC
